We have looked at a number of sites in and around the area (not too far away but far enough) and have decided to revisit one of the National run sites near Hemel Hempstead. The site is called "Phasels Wood" and is run by the Hertfordshire Scout Association. The site is 95 acres in size with 30 acres laid down to woodland camping with several small camping areas, which is perfect for a number of adventurous scouting activities.

During our time away the boys will be camping in tents and will take part in a number of on site activities, which will help them work together towards their challenge badges and at least one activity badge.

The boys will be helping to cook some of their own meals and **washing up !** We will be supported on camp by a Service Team made of Older Scouts and **Eager Helpers (See Below) !**

The cost of the camp will be in the region of £35.00 but we will confirm final costs once firm numbers have been established.

We intend to leave Bedford around 5.00pm on **Friday 28th May** and return back at approx 6.00pm on **Monday 31st May** (Bank Holiday).
